SPIRITUAL GROWTH

INITIATION: CATHECHUMENAL

- Idea that if you are already confirmed, you journey with the person/people undertaking this journey towards baptism. Program starts in Advent.
- Wording: potentially include Teaching & Learning/Questioning etc. in the title for the program.
- Program: Use of the Gospel, why believe, why we baptize, different approaches to prayer and reflection, icons, signs and symbols used in the church, asking questions of the practices that we undertake etc.

CHRIST-CENTRED MINDFULNESS

- Potential for running a day at Macedon as part of our Quiet Day Program.
- Brotherhood of St. Laurence (BSL) conducts mindfulness programs at the BSL.
- Consider running a program within the Parish as part of the Partnership Program with the BSL.

DIVERSITY IN FAITH DEVELOPMENT AND EXPRESSION

- We are one Parish with seven distinct worshipping communities within the Parish.
- Promoting within the Parish that we represent all;
- ensuring that all voices are represented and also recognised within the broader Parish – this is shown through the use of one vicar, representation on bodies such as the Executive and Parish Council.

ONE BODY, MANY PARTS

- Respecting our divergence and finding our common ground in our church life.
- Working with our lay ministry – recruitment into these roles, training around use of chalice.

LITURGICAL EXPRESSION AND DIVERSITY

- Possible growth for further liturgical expression, particularly through the music used in services, and additional evensong services.
- Sunday Arvo @ 5 led by lay people supported by clergy

VITAL AND DYNAMIC MINISTRY

- Important consideration: ongoing ministry and support that we can provide post-wedding and post-baptism to young couples/families.
- Osmosis approach (supporting people who come to us of their own accord) vs Sheep beget sheep approach (actively inviting people in to share in the love of Jesus)
- Baptisms and weddings: recognising anniversaries for families: could be undertaken through the office.

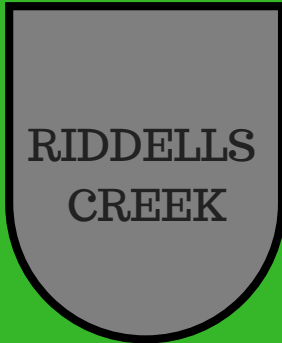
EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY

- Training lay staff to assist with the “Prepare Enrich” program that is offered to couples undertaking marriage. Adoption of families by 1-2 current parishioners when they are preparing for baptism. Inviting parishioners to be present when baptism is being held outside of regular service times.

BREAKING OPEN THE WORD

- Importance of using jargon-free language within sermons and services. Language, tradition, identity – what does it all mean? Looking at the backstory behind names, titles etc
- “Breaking open the word” used instead of “sermon”.
- Parish exec currently following up visiting speakers/preachers.
- Missiology – outward inclusion of the community and beyond.
